In this week's Stewardship Corner, we have updated the "monthly" figures to reflect where we are as of the end of August. Each month, it takes about a week or two after the end of the month for our treasurer, Jim Kopefler, to crunch the numbers for his monthly report, and we offer a HUGE thank you to him for all the work he does!! We do our best to present this information in the most easy-to-understand way, but if you have any questions, please email them to stewardship@oldtownucc.org and we will get you the answers.

Recently, we have been representing our monthly numbers as a percentage of where we need to be for the entire year. In the above example, the first line "END OF AUGUST (67% of the year)" explains that at the end of August, we are 67% of the way (8 of 12 months) to the end of the year. The next line explains that at the end of August, though we are 67% of the way through the year, we have only brought in 17% of our budgeted fundraising amount for the year. This reflects the fact that we have had to cancel our suppers, yard sales, and pet clinics due to the pandemic.

Our budgeted income to date is 52% of the amount for the year, which since we are 67% of the way through the year means we're a little behind. But our budgeted expenses at 50% of the annual amount at 67% of the way through the year, means we're doing very well at keeping our expenses down, because we have not had fundraising expenses and we are not worshiping together in the sanctuary or using the building.
