# TREASURER -Jim Koepfler

- Jim said his numbers were a little smaller than Deb's but he would use her figures
- He had sent a copy of the revised budget sheet. Discussion followed and it was decided that even though we have gone through a difficult and different year, a good job had been done. A year end difference between income and expense was -\$5,392.
- A deficit budget of \$12,727. was proposed. A motion was made by Jim Fennell and seconded by Jim Brinson. All voted in favor.

# **ANNUAL MEETING**

- Discussed whether to push the date into February or to hold it virtually in January by ZOOM. Due to the PAUSE in live worship for the month it was decided to hold the meeting on January 30, 2022 at 11:00 AM via a ZOOM meeting. A ZOOM link will be posted on Sunday morning.
- Pastor Kelly suggested voting in the proposed budget, etc. and then possibly 6 months later holding an in person meeting to discuss the work of the church.
- Ed Clavette will be compiling the annual report booklet and reports of all ministries and officers are due to him by tJan. 17th. Anyone having photos that may be used can send them to Ed.
- Pastor said that Christian Ed had talked last week and it will be more of an over view this year.
