PASTOR

- She's holding things together at this point.
- Wil Sencabaugh, new pastor at Second Church in Attleboro contacted her about possibly sharing summer services as we have long ago. One church would close for July and that congregation would attend the other church, then in August they would switch. Lots of questions to be worked out such as music, deacons, etc. It would save each church from using pulpit supply and each minister would get 4 weeks vacation.
- There could be other projects as well where both churches could work together. We need to think about all this and revisit the issue in March.

- Discussion about opening the church after PAUSE in January. Decided to follow school departments' decision to drop masks after Feb. vacation (Feb. 28). Optional for anyone to continue wearing a mask.

- Having coffee and fellowship was discussed. Deacons will discuss who will do it, signup sheet, etc. at their meeting. They will also discuss communion at that time.

OLD / NEW BUSINESS

- Jim Fennell asked each ministry leader to gather names of those serving and forward to him as soon as they meet.
- Jim is creating a Google calendar as an internal church thing containing lots of in-house information (not seen by general public).

- Jeannette Galvin reported for the Pastoral Relations Ministry on Pastor Kelly's sabbatical. Most churches offer a sabbatical after 5-7 years. She's' been here 12 years and hers is long overdue. Following a sabbatical, pastors are supposed to serve at least one year.
- 6 weeks paid leave from April 18 through June 1. Is the time frame. Pastor Kelly will be here for Easter and back for Pentecost.
- Meeting of all ministry leaders with Deacons and Pastoral Relations will be on Feb. 24 at 6 PM. Discussion will take place on renewing congregation to pull together and keep home fires burning. and perhaps have lay persons --ministry leaders take one week.
- Jim Fennell is working on incorporating all information into Pastor's call agreement in her contract.
- A motion to grant the sabbatical was made by Jeannette Galvin, seconded by Linda Vogler and so passed.
